Risk Statement and Conditions of Inclusion

Boating is by its nature an unpredictable activity. There are inherent risks and dangers in any watersport, as in all worthwhile sports, and participants, especially the young, the vulnerable and the novice of any age, are entitled to standards of vigilance and care to keep them safe. The Trustees wish to inform you that the Skye Sailing Club takes its duty of care very seriously and will work hard to create a safe framework for all participants while boating at an organised event. The Trustees, or its appointees, will take all reasonable steps to minimise any potential risk and this will include the provision of a safety boat manned by qualified personnel.

The Skye Sailing Club Trustees expect those taking part in boating activities to agree and acknowledge that:

- (i) You are aware of the inherent element of risk involved while boating and you accept responsibility for exposing yourself to such inherent risk while taking part in the an event;
- (ii) You and/or your ward will comply at all times with the instructions of the organiser particularly with regard to the handling of boats, wearing of buoyancy aids and the wearing of suitable clothing for the conditions;
- (iii) You and/or your ward accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own negligence;
- (iv) You and/or your ward will not participate in a boating event while under the influence of alcohol, drugs or whilst otherwise unfit to participate;
- (v) You and/or your ward has a duty of care to other members and to the care and proper use of equipment. Ill-disciplined behaviour on the water can lead to injury and damage to boats and this is not acceptable;
- (i) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, as can be practically provided in the circumstances. You are warned that the Club is only able to provide rescue facilities during the hours of club sessions. Outside these hours, You have sole responsibility for yourself and your children and wards. The club cannot accept responsibility for any person not engaged in the boating session.
- (ii) Third party insurance cover is provided while using Club equipment – this does not cover personal effects.
- (vi) In taking part you accept that video and still image capture may be carried out and used for the promotion of the Skye Sailing Club charity in printed press, digital and social media marketing. If you do not wish to be included in any publicity, please let us know by email (info@skyesailingclub.com) 5 days prior to the event you or your ward are booked on.
