The table confirms the minimum number a volunteers needed to run a club session in favourable conditions, however depending on the group size, ability and weather extra volunteers can be added.

All volunteers must be inducted and have completed PVG checks.

Decision Maker

Approved by both the Senior Instructor and Committee to act as the manager and take decisions during non-instructional sailing sessions. Must have a valid First Aid qualification.

Senior Instructor

A qualified RYA Senior Instructor appointed by the club to run either instructional or non-instructional sailing sessions. Must have a valid First Aid qualification.

Instructor

A qualified RYA instructor can only teach under the direct supervision of the Senior Instructor during an instructional session. Out with the direct support from the Senior Instructor an instructor cannot teach but can still help during club sessions.

Rib Driver

A minimum of RYA Powerboat Level 2 must be held, and the driver should be approved to drive the rib during a club session by the Senior Instructor. It is preferable that they have a valid First Aid qualification.

Volunteer

No qualifications are required, just a keenness to help and happy to get wet.

Shore Support

No qualifications are required, just a keenness to help.
